Sita works long hours at the factory to provide for her son. But without stable housing, life was a daily struggle. They slept at the factory, with Sita worried for her son's safety. The transient lifestyle also meant her son could not enroll in school.

We learned of their distress and responded swiftly, funding and constructing a small home adjacent to the factory.

Now Sita can conveniently work her shifts while her son stays safe at home. With a permanent address, Nam could also enroll in a nearby school. The home's proximity to the factory and school provides Sita precious time. Without long transit, she can maximize time with her son in the mornings and evenings. These small moments make their challenging lives richer.



We hope Sita's story inspires further assistance for vulnerable single mothers. With security, education, and care, these women can unlock their potential and raise thriving children. For now, the comforts of home have been transformational for one tenacious mother and son.
