Since its inception in 2017, Care for Cambodia has been deeply committed to improving the lives and living conditions of the Cambodian community. Construction Projects

In 2023 alone, we successfully constructed 12 houses, 3 outdoor kitchens, 4 toilets, a library, and a school fence. Since 2017, we have also built two village wells, consistently monitoring their water quality and longevity, thereby ensuring villagers have access to clean, safe water — a fundamental human right.

Essential Services

Beyond infrastructure, Care for Cambodia recognizes the importance of basic necessities. In 2023, we served food, clothing, and household essentials to over 50 households. This endeavor aimed to enhance the living conditions of the villagers and provide them with a sense of security and dignity.

Education Opportunities

We covered all educational fees, meal plan costs, and tutoring fees, thus removing financial barriers that could hinder their academic progress. Among these children is an aspiring medical student, whose ambition to serve her community is a testament to the hope and resilience we aim to cultivate.



Community Empowerment

Our organization grew significantly from 2017, recruiting over 50 additional part-time and freelance workers. This expansion not only enhanced our operational capacity but also created job opportunities, contributing to the local economy.

Moreover, we initiated the creation of a community garden. This project promotes sustainable agriculture, and fosters a sense of community ownership and cooperation. It



provides a source of fresh produce for the villagers, and the act of gardening itself has therapeutic benefits.
