

The School Library

A humble new building is sparking big dreams in Kampong Thom, Cambodia. This structure is the village's first ever school library, built by Care For Cambodia and partners. In coordination with village leaders and teachers, we responded to the need for more educational resources. Rural students have limited access to books and computers. A library would provide the tools to unlock their potential.

Funds were raised to construct a simple structure near the village school. Shelves were stocked with donated books in Khmer and English. The library opened its doors last month to thrilled students. The library has since become a hub of learning and discovery.



Teachers have also embraced the library for expanding lessons beyond outdated textbooks. Students' literacy and research skills are improving rapidly thanks to diverse reading materials.

With this successful first library, we hope to construct more in underserved villages. The nonprofit believes access to education resources is crucial for empowering rural youth to break the cycle of

poverty. For now, this new community treasure is opening up worlds of information and opportunity, book by book.
